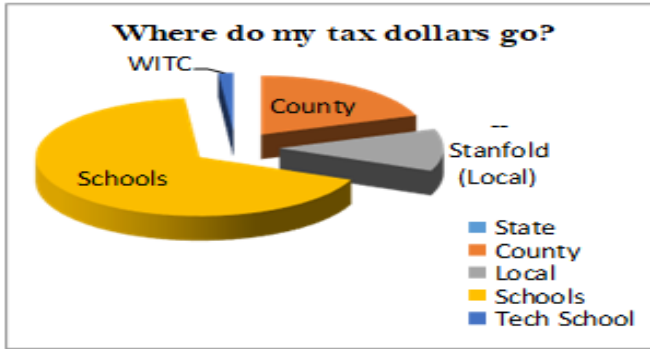


STANFOLD NEWSLETTER 2021-2022

- **Town Picnic** - July 30st at Noon @ Town Shop.
The Town will provide water, ice cream, root beer, brats & hot dogs! Bring a dish to pass and join us!
- **Town Hall Rental**- Town Residents can rent the Town Hall for \$25/day or \$50/day with heat.
- **Snow Plowing** – State law prohibits plowing snow across town roads from driveways. It is a safety hazard; violators may be fined and liable for damages.
- **Mailboxes** – Post less than 4” in diameter, 36” from shoulder of road, 42”-50” above the road surface and may not extend into the shoulder of road.
- **Burning Permits**- Snow on the ground- no permit required. No snow - call the Town Chairman for a permit, no charge. You will then need to call the Barron Co. Sheriff’s Department at 715-537-3106.
- **Sand/salt** is available at the Town Shop for residents no charge if they need a pail or two.
- **Fire Calls** – Please be aware that the Town has an ordinance requiring land and homeowners to pay for 100% of all fire bills (Fire fighters/trucks) for every fire call to their property.
- **Work done in 2021:** Many new culverts and bridges replaced, 3 miles of new gravel on 13 ¼ St., Crack sealed 19th Ave, purchased a new tractor/mower, Town Hall now has new flagpole, ramp, mailbox, a clerk’s office, siding, windows, bulletin board.
- **Some of many plans for 2022:** Replace bridges on 24th Ave, add a bathroom to the Town Shop, gravel on 13th Street, new ramp entrance west door at hall...

Licenses are required before 2/28/22:

\$10.00 for each unaltered dog

\$5.00 for each spayed/neutered dog

***A copy of your rabies vaccination certificate is required for each dog and must be included with your payment.**

Tony Weigand is the new Barron County Animal Control Deputy. Rabies Vaccinations and licensing is required in Barron County. Failure to do so, will result in citations from the County.
